



Average Rehearsal

Welcome to our classroom! This sheet will allow you to follow an average Dodge City High School Choral Music rehearsal. Students enrolled receive learning which is oriented and designed to master the basic concepts of Kansas State Music Standards, plus an energetic approach to all aspects of vocal music from Classical Choral Music to Vocal Theatre with a touch of Ethnic and Cultural Music. Music is a world language which knows no borders and universally brings people of all cultures together as equals.

OBJECTIVE: Students will actively participate in all music activities and achieve his/her best effort every class period while having FUN!

The Rehearsal Period

85 minute class periods

Meeting 2-3 times per week

ANNOUNCEMENTS

(2-5 minutes)

Daily announcements of school, classroom and community events.

WARM-UP

(5-15 minutes)

All three learning methods are primed: Cognitive (thought), Psychomotor (movement/physical), and Affective (emotional).

SIGHT SINGING/RHYTHM

(5-10 minutes)

Refinement of sight reading skills, which are essential to excellent choral ability. Both aural (hearing) and visual (sight) skills are enhanced.

TEAM BUILDING/PROBLEM SOLVING

(5-10 minutes)

Students work together to become a cohesive unit capable of working together.

APPLIED MUSIC PERFORMANCE REHEARSAL

(50 minutes +)

Singing of choral/vocal music in class and as sectional rehearsal, discussion of music theory, music history, and relationship recall.
